

Policy Connect uses the following cookies on this website, for the following purposes:

Google Analytics

_gat (Performance)

This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics, according to documentation it is used to throttle the request rate - limiting the collection of data on high traffic sites. It expires after 10 minutes.

_gid (Performance)

This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics. This appears to be a new cookie and as of Spring 2017 no information is available from Google. It appears to store and update a unique value for each page visited.

_ga (Performance)

This cookie name is associated with Google Universal Analytics - which is a significant update to Google's more commonly used analytics service. This cookie is used to distinguish unique users by assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. It is included in each page request in a site and used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the sites analytics reports. By default it is set to expire after 2 years, although this is customisable by website owners.

AddThis

__atuvc, __atuvs (Functionality)

These cookies are associated with the AddThis social sharing widget which is commonly embedded in websites to enable visitors to share content with a range of networking and sharing platforms. It stores an updated page share count.

Content Management System (Drupal)

has_js (Functionality)

Our content management system, Drupal, uses this cookie to indicate whether or not the visitor's browser has JavaScript enabled.

Drupal.toolbar.collapsed (Functionality)

Our Content Management System, Drupal, sets these cookies to store user interface preferences.

ctools-collapsible-state (Functionality)

This cookie is placed by the content management system to remember whether collapsible items are open or closed. The cookie is deleted when you close your web browser.

Drupal.tableDrag.showWeight, Drupal.visitor.admin_compact_mode, ctools-collapsible-state (Functionality)

These cookies are placed by the content management system, Drupal, to remember display preferences.
